



Privacy Policy

STAR Transit, a political subdivision of the State of Texas, maintains this site (<http://www.STARtransit.org/>) as a public service. This policy describes STAR Transit's privacy practices regarding information collected from visitors to the site. It contains information about what information is collected and how that information may be used. This Privacy Policy may be changed by STAR Transit at any time without notice. Nothing contained in this Privacy Policy shall be construed as specific legal advice. **Please note that, with certain exceptions, the majority of information collected or maintained by STAR Transit may be subject to the provisions of Chapter 552 of the Texas Government Code (Texas Public Information Act).** Regardless of the information being transmitted to STAR Transit, all such information will be protected consistent with applicable law. The privacy of our customers and the security of this site are the utmost importance to STAR Transit. This policy applies to all pages beginning with www.STARtransit.org.

Notice of Monitored Use:
